Basic Information

- The presentation runs in a single act with no interval for 55 minutes.
- The show is presented by Jon Spooner, Artistic Director of Unlimited
- The show is suitable for everyone over 14.
- There is a short Q&A session at the end.

What we need from you

- A large classroom with clear space at the front to enable projection screens and projectors to work effectively. Blinds or curtains required.
- Access to this space without interruption for at least 1.5 hours before and half an hour after the presentation to enable set-up and dismantling.
- Seating for pupils (maximum 35 per session)
- Access to 3 x 13amp sockets
- A parking space for a small van and clear level access to the room we'll be using
- Some nice coffee always goes down well...

What we'll bring

- A fantastic, accessible, thought provoking and inspiring show about quantum physics
- Two 'pull up' stand alone roller projection screens,
- Two optomax projectors that need to sit approx 3 metres from the screens on 2 stools that we will bring.
- A PC laptop used by the performer to operate the projections that accompany the performance.
- All the cable we could ever possibly need.
